# 1. Age Categories

Men and Women 55+

# 2. Events

Discipline divisions within each event.

- a) Arena Driving Trial
- b) Dressage
- c) Mountain Trail not in 2022 Games
- d) Western Dressage
- e) Western Performance not in 2022 Games
- f) Working Hunter
- g) Working Equitation

# 3. Participation

- a) Each zone may send an unlimited number of participants in each age category and event.
- b) One horse per participant. One horse may be shared by two different participants in separate events. Participants must compete in all events with the same horse.
- c) Participants may compete in a maximum of two discipline divisions. The medal results will be determined by total of combined scores from all discipline events

# 4. Competition

- a) Horse Council BC rules will apply with 55+ BC Games exceptions.
- b) The Host Society Sport Chair will post schedules, draws and results at the venue throughout the competition.
- c) Each participant will be assigned an entry number, which must be worn at all times during the competition.
- d) Tests, classes or patterns will be ridden each day.
- e) Participants are responsible to pay any stable or camping fees required to the facility on arrival.
- f) There will be no gate holds.

# 5. Medals

- a) Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to top three participants in each discipline division.
- b) Medal presentations will take place at the end of the competition at the venue.
